Swimming Pool Rules

The pool is open! Please review the rules below and respect all guests at the Club so that everyone can have a safe and enjoyable time at the pool.

- 1. Children under ten years of age must be accompanied by a parent, responsible adult or a responsible babysitter. Babysitter must be 16 years of age or older. This rule will be strictly enforced. Violator's will lose pool privileges.*
- 2. No one is permitted in the pool area when the signs reading "Pool Closed" are in place.*
- 3. Running, pushing, dunking, diving, rough games and/or horseplay is not permitted in the pool area.*
- 4. Rafts and inner tubes may be used in the pool at the discretion of the lifeguard.*
- 5. Anyone may be called upon by the staff to prove their swimming ability at any time.*
- 6. Swimming attire is not permitted in the Clubhouse or bar area, or on the putting green and golf course.*
- 7. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property.*
- 8. All members and guests must register with the lifeguard. Guests will be subject to a fee determined by the Board of Governors.*
- 9. Glassware and/or glass bottles are not permitted within the gated area of the pool.*
- 10. Outside food and/or beverages are not permitted at the pool or clubhouse.*
- 11. Children under 12 are not permitted on the putting green unless accompanied by an adult.*
- 12. Children must be accompanied by an adult in the locker rooms. Towels are not to be removed from the locker rooms.*
- 13. Pool hours are at the discretion of the Club Manager.*
